Message from the Director

2023 was a great year for the Library as it continued its comeback from the Pandemic years. There was growth in the number of visitors, the amount of materials borrowed and the attendance at our programs.

In addition to these successes, the Library also partnered with the Town Of Mount Pleasant Engineering Department to develop a phased plan of implementation for the Library's Master Plan. The Town of Mount Pleasant and Village of Pleasantville are currently reviewing this plan. In spite of high inflation pressures, expenditures were controlled in 2023: as a result, the Library's fund balances are in a healthy condition and the Library is in a position to contribute significantly to future capital improvements.

Looking to 2024, our hope is to continue to grow our services, connect with the community and to partner with the Town and Village to begin the first phase of the Master Plan.

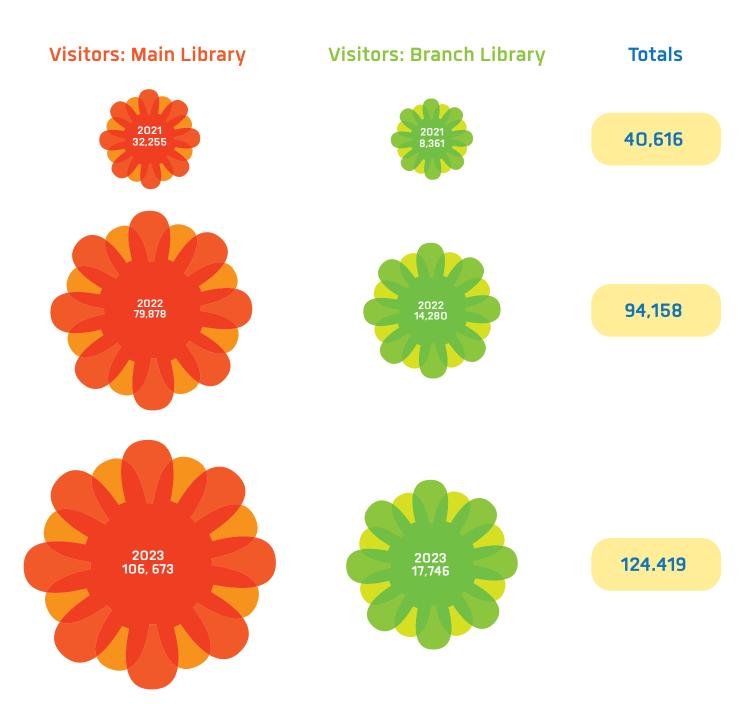

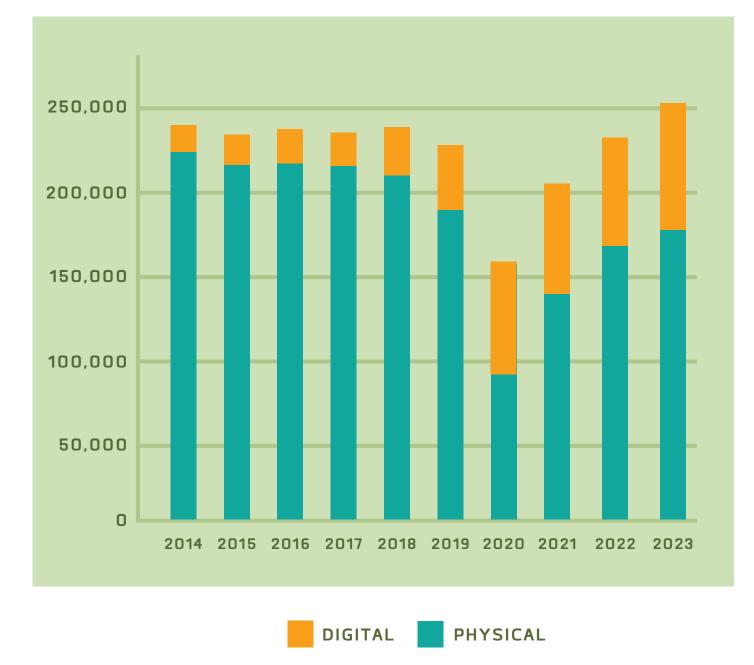

VISITORS



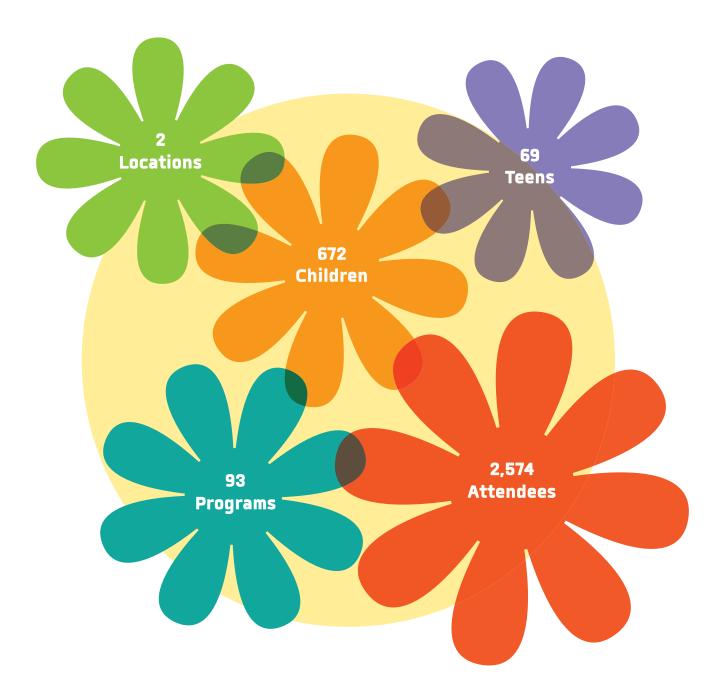
We had a 32% increase in the number of visitors to our libraries last year (compared to 2022)

MASTER PLAN

At the request of the Town and Village, the Library worked with the Town Engineering Department last year to develop a phased implementation schedule for the Library's Master Plan.



The phased approach will allow us to realize the vision of the Master Plan in a cost effective manner, and to continue to provide a full range of library services through the four construction phases.

The Library Board has recommended to the Town and Village that work begin as soon as possible on Phase 1. The Town and Village are currently evaluating the report.

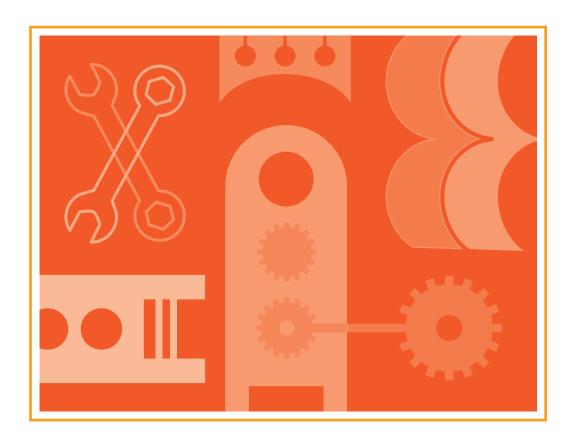
